"Our foot-traffic and adoption numbers have increased, we do mega-community outreach, yet we are always full with these cuties," said Aaron Reyes, Director of Operations for SEAACA.

Thanks to the generosity and kindness of an Edmonton Humane Society donor, thirty small dogs from SEAACA will be flown to the Edmonton Humane Society in Alberta, Canada on June 25th, 2010 out of Long Beach Airport.

She is a wonderful woman who truly wants to help shelter animals that so desperately seek a second chance at a new home," Reyes said. "Who would have thought we'd be shipping our dogs out of the country to find them their new family? This transport program called **California Canine Cuties** will also include animals from the Central California SPCA (CCSPCA). “We are all full in Southern California, yet the intake door just keeps swinging. These transports truly save lives, and we are so grateful to the kind souls like Jan Folk who make these flights happen,” Reyes said.
